PHILLY AND SOUTH JERSEY'S GREAT WEDDING NIGHT HIDEAWAYS

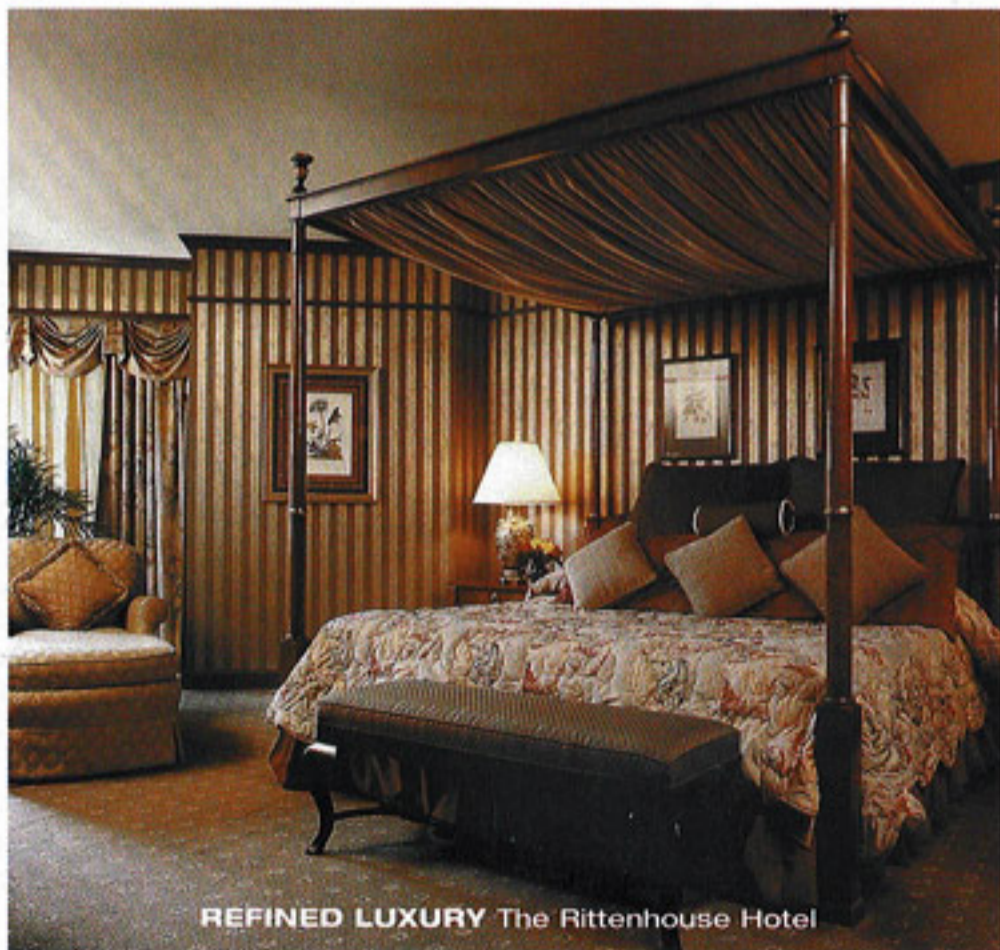
