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## CHOCOLATE

Smooth textures and deep flavors set these treats apart from what's in the regular candy jar.

**1. BAR NONE.** Fudge Truffle Bars from Bodega Chocolates (\$3 each) come in seven flavors, ranging from the basic (bittersweet) to the exotic (*dulce de leche*).

**2. SWEET THINGS.** Clockwise from top: Lacroix at The Rittenhouse assorted chocolates flavored with fruit, tea, herbs, and liqueur (\$36 per pound); B. T. McElrath All-Butter English Toffee and "Picnics" bittersweet drops with dried fruit and nuts (\$28 for 8 ounces and \$12 for a 5-piece box, respectively); Wegman's Chocolates by

Pierre Hermé (truffle and ganache shown; \$33 per pound); and Valor individually wrapped chocolates in assorted flavors (\$16 for a 12-ounce tin). Ceramic plate with perforated rim from Amaran (\$45).

**3. GO NUTS.** The confections in Godiva's Nut & Chocolate Collection contain almonds, pecans, macadamia nuts, and hazelnuts. Choose from individual croquant pieces (\$15 for 12 pieces or \$25 for 20 pieces) and milk or dark chocolate almond bark (\$34 per pound).
