### WHITE WINES

#### CHARDONNAY

Chalone Estate, Monterey County, 2009

The cooling effect of the nearby Pacific Ocean allows the grapes to slowly ripen, giving this Chardonnay firm acidity, crisp pear and apple flavors. The wine has a nice balance of American oak.

Chardonnay, Century Cellars, Vineyard Select, Beaulieu Vineyards, California, 2008

Rich tropical citrus and apple flavors with a slight oak influence.

#### COTES DU RHONE

« Les Abeilles », Colombo, 2009

From renowned winemaker, Jean-Luc Colombo, this blend of Roussanne and Marsanne grapes features nice fruit, a dry and full finish, with just the right touch of oak.

Roberston, South Africa, 2009

## **PINOT GRIGIO**

Stival, Italy, 2009

From the Friuli Veneto region comes this dry, light and unoaked wine. Well-balanced with a refreshing finish.

## **RIESLING**

Riesling, Rhein River, Rheinhessen, Germany, 2008

## **SAUVIGNON BLANC**

Penascal, Castilla y Leon, Spain, 2009

A refreshing, crisp and unoaked white wine from North Western Spain with a lovely citrus finish

Zolo, Mendoza, Argentina 2010

Brilliant yellow color; delicate and intense aromas of tropical flowers.

Canyon Oaks, California, 2009

A lovely white zinfandel, light bodied and fruit forward



## RED WINES

### **CARMÉNÈRE**

Paso del Sol, Chile, 2009

From the Valle Central, a deliciously juicy, mouth-filling red wine packed with blackberry fruit on the palate, followed by a long, smooth, velvety finish.

### **CABERNET SAUVIGNON**

Canyon Oaks, California, 2009

A beautifully crafted Cabernet with generous fruit and body; oak-aged, supple with round tannins.

### **MALBEC**

Tierra Brisa, Mendoza, Argentina, 2010

Intense red color, taste of ripe plum with soft vanilla, notes lingering on the palate.

### **MERLOT**

Beaulieu Vineyard, Signet Collection, Central Coast, 2006

Balance and rich with robust complexity this Merlot is barrel-aged and displays distinctive ripe berry flavors, notes of toasty oak and a velvety finish.

Foppiano, Russian River Valley, Sonoma County, 2005

This Sonoma County Merlot is round and medium bodied with a good balance of acidity, soft tannins and nicely integrated oak.

### **BARBERA D'ASTI**

Araldica, Asti, Italy, 2007

Matured in oak casks, a round and medium-bodied wine with warm, smoky aromas.



## **PINOT NOIR**

Le Grand Noir, Pays d'Oc, 2009

From the Pays d'Oc, an oak-aged Pinot Noir in the French tradition, with aromas of black and red fruits.

## **SHIRAZ**

Kilda, Southeastern Australia, 2009

A rich and full body red wine, spicy and smoky, aged in oak barrels.

## **TEMPRANILLO**

Picos, La Mancha, Spain, 2009

Long Ageing in American oak barrels. Complex nose of cherry and vanilla

Velvety smooth texture with great spiciness
