WHITE WINES

CHARDONNAY

- Chalone Estate, Monterey County, 2007 - 52
The cooling effect of the nearby Pacific Ocean allows the grapes to slowly ripen, giving this Chardonnay firm acidity, crisp pear and apple flavors. The wine has a nice balance of American oak.
- Chardonnay, Century Cellars, Vineyard Select, Beaulieu Vineyards, California, 2007 -38
Rich tropical citrus and apple flavors with a slight oak influence.



COTES DU RHONE

« Les Abeilles » 2006 - 48
From renowned winemaker, Jean-Luc Colombo, this blend of Roussanne and Marsanne grapes features nice fruit, a dry and full finish, with just the right touch of oak.

GEWURZTRAMINER

Banyan, Monterey County, 2008 -52
“A lovely off-dry Gewürztraminer in the Alsatian style. Unoaked, with a wonderful bouquet, a touch of spice and a pleasant finish”

PINOT GRIGIO

Stival, Italy, 2007 - 38
From the Friuli Veneto region comes this dry, light and unoaked wine. Well-balanced with a refreshing finish.

Santa Margherita, Italy, 2007 - 66
The most famous Pinot Grigio from Italy for good reasons. Dry, crisp and fruity with a bright, appealing bouquet.

RIESLING

Riesling, Rhein River, Rheinhessen, Germany, 2007 -43
Starts with a wonderful bouquet of fresh peaches.. Enticing mineral nuances. Crisp , pure, and balanced.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Penascal, Castilla y Leon, Spain, 2007 -44
A refreshing, crisp and unoaked white wine from North Western Spain with a lovely citrus finish

WHITE ZINFANDEL

Mountain View, California, 2008 - 38
A lovely white zinfandel, light bodied and fruit forward.



RED WINES

BORDEAUX

Chateau La Rose Tour Blanche, 2006 - 48
A great blend of Cabernet and Merlot, with soft tannins, light oak and a dry finish.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Canyon Oaks, California, 2008 - 38
A beautifully crafted Cabernet with generous fruit and body; oak-aged, supple with round tannins.

Lapis Luna, Lodi County, California, 2005 -46
A wonderful balance of black cherry and earthy flavors, great depth and a hint of oak.

MALBEC

Simond, Vrede en Lust, South Africa, 2004 - 48
A wonderful blend of Shiraz-Cabernet-Merlot-Malbec. With a lovely smokiness, a firm backbone and layers of complexity.

MERLOT

Beaulieu Vineyard, Signet Collection, Central Coast, 2004 - 48
Balance and rich with robust complexity this Merlot is barrel-aged and displays distinctive ripe berry flavors, notes of toasty oak and a velvety finish.

Foppiano, Russian River Valley, Sonoma County, 2002 - 58
This Sonoma County Merlot is round and medium bodied with a good balance of acidity, soft tannins and nicely integrated oak.

MONASTRELL

Las Reñas, Bullas, Spain, 2006 -46
From South Eastern Spain, Mediterranean climate and high altitude. Floral aromas, spice, vibrant fruit and structured finish.



PINOT NOIR

Domaine Lurton, France, 2006

- 48

From the Pays d'Oc, an oak-aged Pinot Noir in the French tradition, with aromas of black and red fruits.

PRIMITIVO

Petraio, Puglia, Italy, 2007

-46

From the heel of the Italian Peninsula Boot, Primitivo is the European ancestor of Zinfandel. With faint raspberry and chalk aromas, a medium-bodied and lightly-oaked red wine; wonderful balance with good spice and nice acidity.

SHIRAZ

Kilda, Southeastern Australia, 2008

-44

A rich and full body red wine, spicy and smoky, aged in oak barrels.
